

## WMA RESOLUTION ON **FEMALE FOETICIDE**

Adopted by the 53<sup>rd</sup> WMA General Assembly, Washington, DC, USA, October 2002 and reaffirmed by the 191st WMA Council Session, Prague, Czech Republic, April 2012

- 1. Whereas there is grave concern that in certain countries female foeticide is commonly practised.
- 2. The WMA denounces female foeticide as a totally unacceptable example of gender discrimination.
- 3. The World Medical Association calls on National Medical Associations:
  - To denounce the practice of female foeticide and the use of selective sex determination for that purpose and;
  - To advise their governments accordingly
