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DEFINITION

Research

"A process of systematic inquiry or study of the materials and behaviours of the physical and natural world through observation, experimentation, and testing of theories against evidence."

It involves the collection of data through defined methodologies, analysis, and interpretation of the data to generate findings





Public interest Vs Interest Grp Approach


- Transparently communicates its results/developments
